Hajj

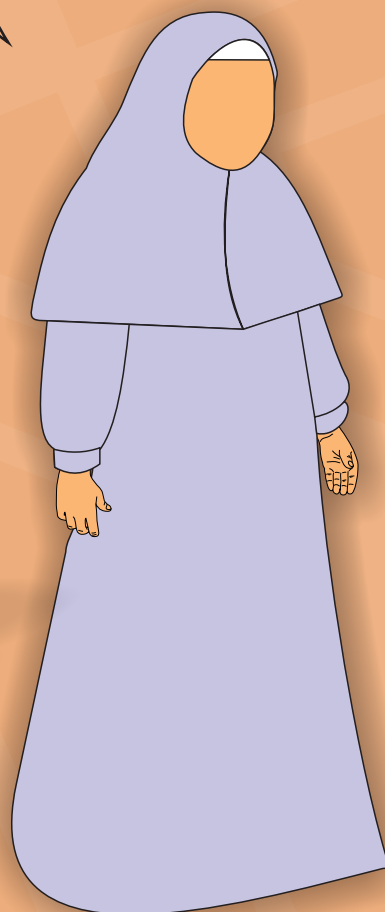
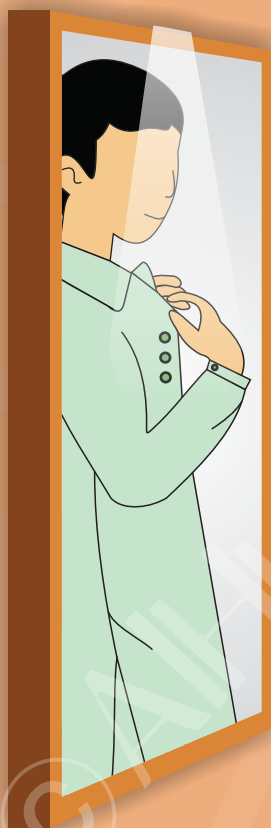

- Recite Takbīrāt

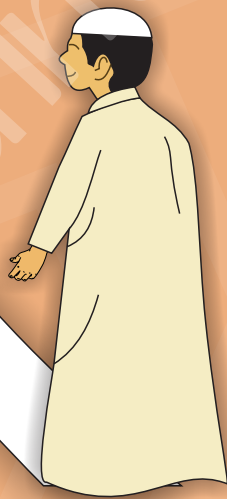
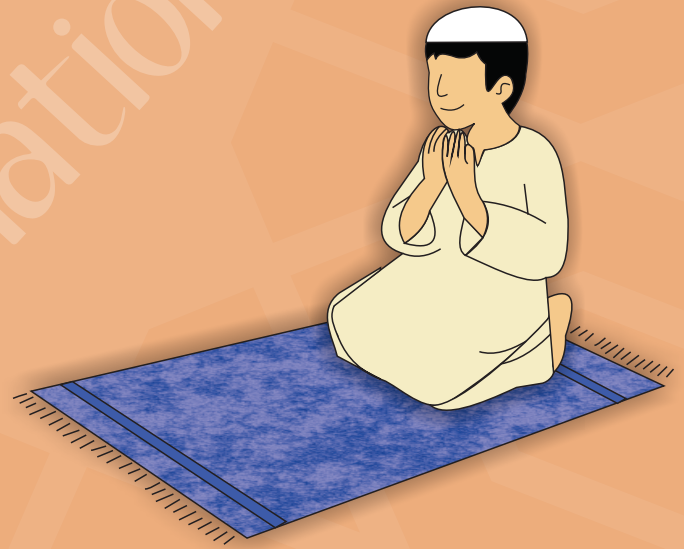

- Not eat anything before the Eid prayer



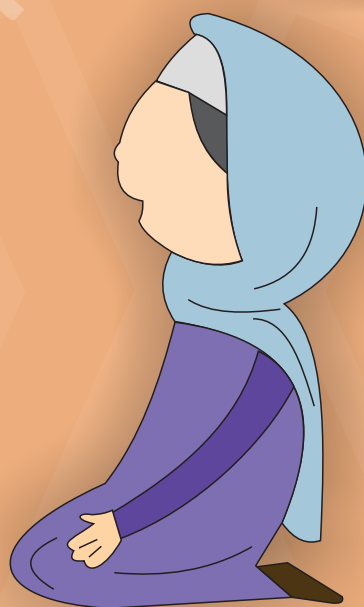
- Go to offer the Eid prayer
