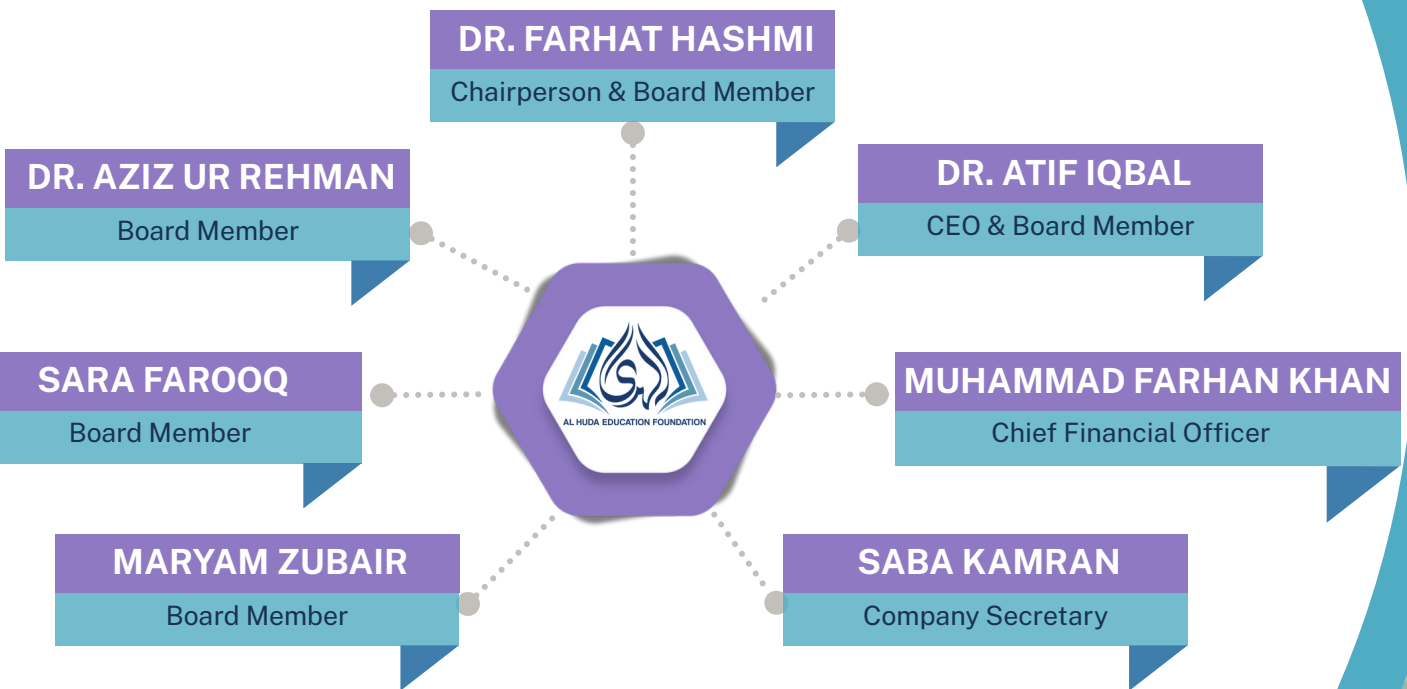




Transfer of Operations to **AL HUDA EDUCATION FOUNDATION**

To support the growing scale of our educational initiatives, a strategic decision was made to establish a dedicated foundation for formal education.

Al Huda Education Foundation (AEF), a non-profit organisation registered under Section 42 of SECP, has been established, with Dr. Farhat Hashmi as Chairperson, and four additional Board Members.



Effective July 1, 2025, all schooling operations, assets, and liabilities of AlHuda International Schools (AIS) and AlHuda Community Schools (ACS) are officially transferred to Al Huda Education Foundation (AEF) from Al-Huda International Welfare Foundation (AIWF).

This transition marks a significant milestone in strengthening the governance, sustainability, and future growth of our schools and education initiatives, while staying true to the mission of nurturing hearts and minds through authentic Islamic education.

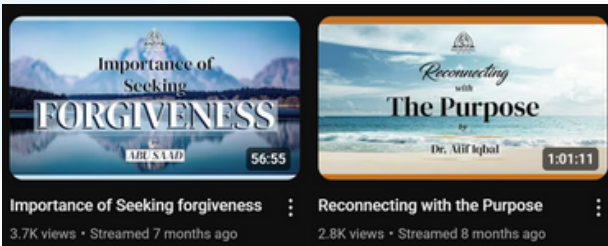
School Leadership Program 2024

AIS Parents' App Launch

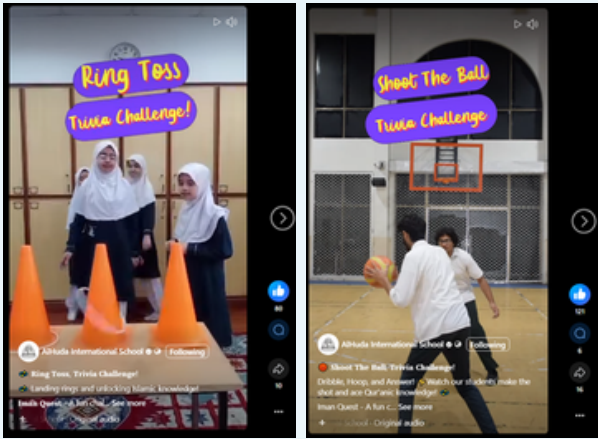


Launched in September 2024, the **AIS Parents' App** marked a major step forward in strengthening school-home communication.

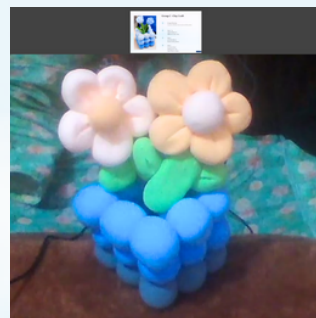
Online Summer Camp 2025

This initiative has opened new avenues for students to pursue higher education in Pakistan's leading colleges and universities, while remaining firmly grounded in academic excellence and Islamic values.

An equally important milestone was the implementation of segregated campuses at higher levels. The H-11 Campus now serves as the Boys' Branch, while the F-8 Campus continues as the Girls' Branch, fostering an environment aligned with Islamic principles and conducive to focused learning.

Key features of the program include:

- Expert faculty committed to excellence and mentorship
- Balanced focus on spiritual, academic, and personal growth
- State-of-the-art facilities for learning and research

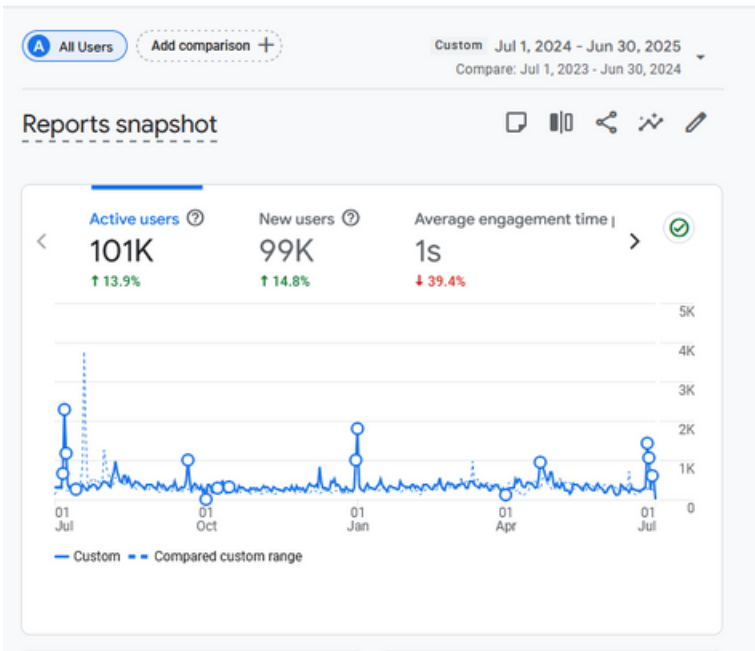

AIS Website PERFORMANCE OVERVIEW



The Website Insights from 1st July 2024 to 30th June 2025 indicate substantial growth, with active users increasing by nearly 14% compared to the previous period largely fueled by organic search.

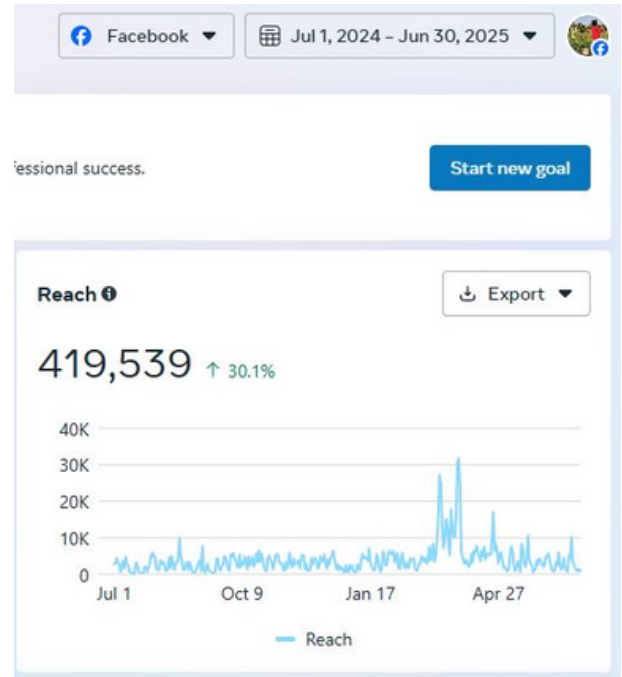


Facebook Growth (July 2024 – June 2025)

Both modules are now available on the Tadrib website with recorded sessions, resources, and tasks for flexible, self-paced learning.

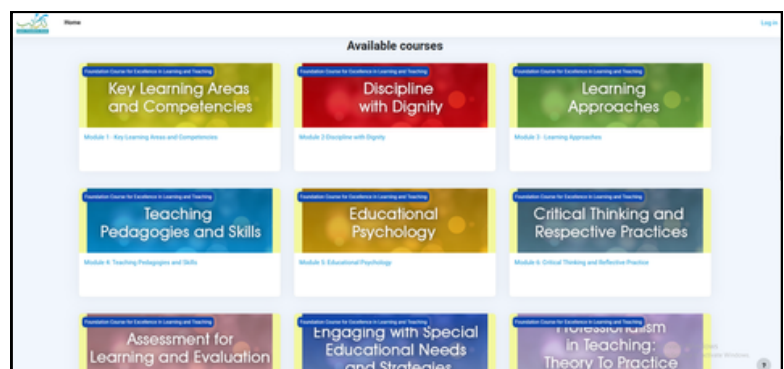
Training Progress (as of May 2025)

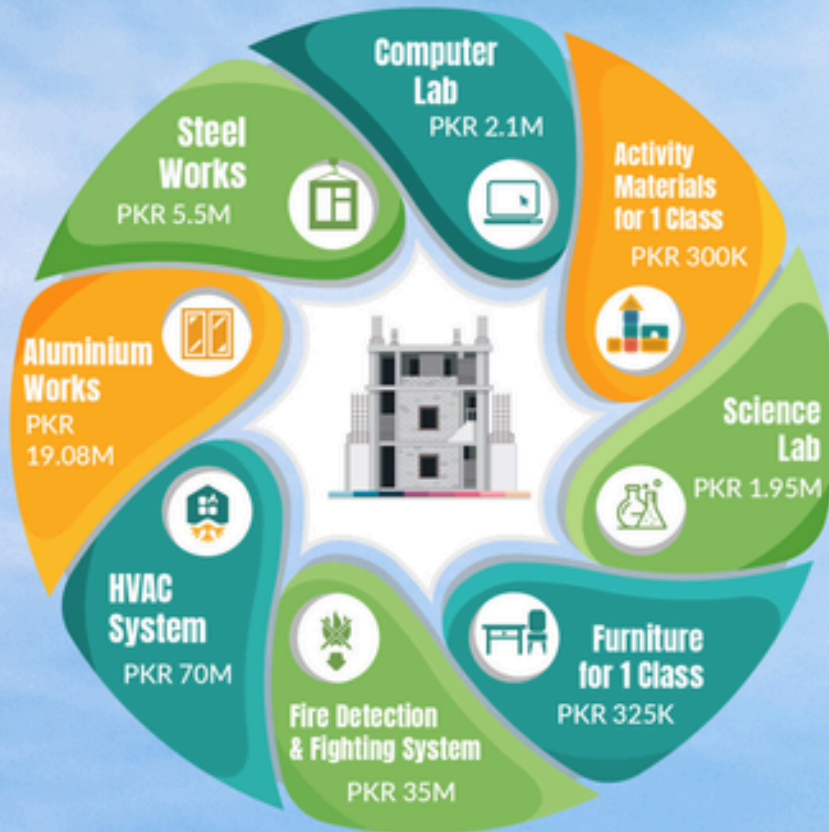
