IGCSE & A Levels MAY/JUNE '22 Results

F-8 Campus, Islamabad: CAIE IGCSE May/June '22 Results at AlHuda International School's F-8 Campus in Islamabad were exceptional, with 126 out of 130 students achieving the highest A* grade, 143 students earning A grades, and 91 students attaining B grades. Remarkably, 55 students achieved A





















grades in all their subjects, showcasing their dedication to studies and the school's commitment to effective teaching.

In the A Levels May/June '22 Results, 22 AS Level students demonstrated outstanding performance, securing 28 A grades, 9 B grades, and 13 C grades. Similarly, in the A2 Level, 16 students participated and achieved 9 A grades, 7 B grades, and 19 C grades. These outstanding results reflect the unwavering dedication and hard work of both students and teachers.
