According to AIS Admission Policy, at around 7 years of age your child is suitable to be admitted in Grade II, which is the second stage of the 4 years Primary schooling of AIS academic Programme. The following literacy and numeracy skills are required in your child as prerequisites for this grade:

- Read the given paragraph/short rhyme/poem independently with correct pronunciation fluency and intonation and confidence.

- Story writing (using story mapping, story board, giving new endings to a story)
- Recounts
