

End of Term Tests – Primary/Secondary Section

Our academic session consists of three terms. The session begins from August and ends in June. The End of Term Tests take place in the months of November, February and June respectively. The grading and assessment system is one that is made comprehensible for the students and parents to reflect upon the child's progress and set future targets.

Grade I

1. There are no **End Term Tests** for Term 1, Term 2 and Term 3 in Grade I.
2. Grade I will continue with continuous assessment system **Formative + Summative assessments** in all 3 terms for all the subjects.
3. There will be an End of Unit / Chapter test to ensure students are making the right progress.
4. Students will be assessed during their teaching lessons.

Grade II to VII

1. Each Term Test is conducted for the syllabus covered in that particular term.
2. There will be an End of Unit Assessment after every Unit / Chapter for English, Mathematics and Science and at the end of every month for the rest of the subjects.
3. For Grade II to VII there will be End Term Tests for all the subjects in the three Terms.

Progression Tests

1. From Grade II -VII progression tests will take place for the subjects English, Math and Science. These tests will only take place in Term 3 and will cover the syllabus of entire year.
2. Progression Tests are skill based tests and bear no additional costs to the parents.
3. These are received from Cambridge and are checked against the marking schemes provided by Cambridge for Primary and Lower Secondary Sections.

Grade VIII IGCSE

1. Assessment for subjects like QTT and QRM, End of Term Tests will be conducted with the syllabus covered in each term.
2. There will be a formal Unit Test at the end of every month.
3. Regular feedback to the students will be provided and remedial will be arranged from the beginning of the session.
4. Assessments for Cambridge IGCSE Subjects i.e **Pakistan Studies and Islamiyat** Term Tests will be conducted in 1st and 2nd Term with the syllabus covered in the respective Terms.
5. In 3rd Term, **entire syllabus covered** in that year will be assessed along with some important topics from year VII.
