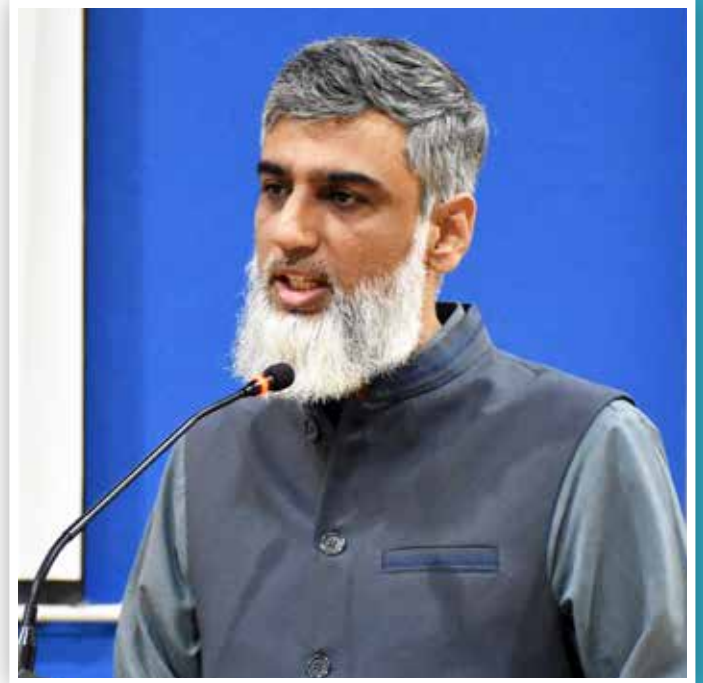

Montessori

Section

AIS provides one of the best Montessori set-ups in Pakistan, successfully using Montessori material for hands-on learning Alhamdulillah. We believe that Montessori learning is learning for life! Therefore, our focus is to link our children with Allah ﷻ in everything they do and to develop a strong foundation of faith for their entire lives.

Harmoniously blended with the Islamic view of a child's Fitrah (nature), the 'Montessori methodology' adopted at AIS is an exceptional system. This methodology is further enhanced by providing the students freedom of choice, respecting their natural development whilst promoting independent learning.

AIS Montessori is a 3 year comprehensive program, which starts at the age of 3 years and may go upto 6+ years. The time from birth till the age of 6 is considered the 'golden period' for a child to learn, understand and grow. We use this golden period to make our students independent in learning by giving them rich experiences to explore as well as steering them towards Islam.



Environment

Providing an ideally prepared environment, AIS Montessori is designed to ensure the effective and holistic development of students. Children benefit from a full range of high-quality Montessori materials and hands-on learning experiences. Rooted in Islamic values, the learning environment inspires, guides, and celebrates students' efforts and achievements. With two teachers in each class and a low student-teacher ratio of 10:1, every child receives individual attention and promotes healthy eating habits. Trained teachers integrate Islamic values into daily teaching, encourage curiosity, inspire creativity, and strive to make each learner's experience successful.



Approach

AIS Montessori follows a child-centred approach through engaging, activity-based learning that fosters independence, organization, and responsibility. Students help themselves to take worksheets and materials from the shelves, put their bags in cubbies, use place-mats at lunch time and tidy up after activities.

Curriculum

The AIS Montessori curriculum is based on established Montessori methods and standards, further enriched by AIS professionals to meet the following objectives:

- *Inculcate strong Islamic values in the students.*
- *Help the students in their intellectual, emotional, physical and social development.*
- *Enable the students to become independent learners.*
- *Help each student to recognize and understand his/her role in the world.*
- *Prepare the students to become Da'ees (preachers) of Islam.*

At AIS Montessori, the balanced approach in curriculum designing, focuses not only on the students' physical and mental grooming, but also on their spiritual uplifting. The activity-based methodology emphasizes creativity along with Tarbiyah as the main feature of AIS Montessori. The students begin their day with the remembrance of Allah ﷻ during specially prepared assemblies.

Arabic language

The Arabic language starts right from Junior Montessori, so that the children are able to practice it by the time they reach the higher grades. This is considered a key to unite Muslims all over the world and to understand the Book of Allah ﷻ in the language it was revealed in. Aqeedah and Ahadith are taught in Arabic to acquaint students with the foundational sources of Islam from an early age. The Montessori students use specially designed Arabic workbooks, developed in-house, which help the children build Arabic vocabulary quickly and practice Arabic letters.

Qur'an Recitation and Memorization

It is essential for every Muslim, to be able to recite the Qur'an in the perfect manner, hence students of Montessori practice Tajweed and memorize daily Du`ās and Azkar of our Prophet ﷺ as well as selected Surahs of the Qur'an. These lessons are reinforced with recommended apps & resources listed at our website:

www.aispk.org/TajweedResources.

English

The students are encouraged to communicate in the English language. The Language Exercises in the Montessori environment develop students' overall language skills. Moreover, the spoken abilities are enhanced through daily practice of phonics, whereas the reading skills are developed through an intense levelled Reading Program. We follow a Synthetic Phonic Program using interactive boards to enhance the listening and reading capability of students. The written expression is polished through a well-structured curriculum focused on appreciating creativity along with improving the hand writing.

Urdu

Urdu language is highly valued at the school and is taught with the same zeal and emphasis as English and Arabic.

Mathematics

Special Montessori material is used to make Mathematics a fun and an exciting subject. It helps to build concrete base of numeracy which would help these students in future to learn and apply complex mathematical concepts to real- life problems.

Islamic Studies

At AIS, Islamic Studies is a subject thoroughly enjoyed by our students. The lessons are planned in line with the Montessori methodology and are based on imparting not just knowledge but practical application of all concepts making it relevant to the child's age and perception. The focus is also on inculcating the love of Allah ﷻ, Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and the Holy Qur'an into the very hearts of our students. We use our own workbooks, developed in-house for Montessori section by the Tarbiyah Department and do our best to instil thorough understanding of Islam.



Moral Education

Moral Education classes from Junior to Advance Montessori focus on building strong Islamic values and good character in young learners. Through engaging activities and meaningful discussions, students learn executive skills and values like honesty, respect, responsibility, and kindness within Islamic worldview. This nurturing approach supports their moral and emotional growth, helping them develop into confident and caring individuals.

Cultural Studies

Culture Studies are an important part of our Montessori curriculum. They broaden students' understanding of the world around them and their place in it. Our students learn this subject through selected topics from Geography, History, Botany, Zoology, Science and Social Studies. This subject is replaced with the subject of Science in Advance Montessori.

2D & 3D Art

Exploring 2D & 3D Art stimulates creativity and broadens the mind. Painting, cutting and sticking drawing, making patterns with symmetry and recycling are all fun ways to learn art and craft.

Practical Life

Exercises of Practical Life are vital for our Montessori students. They help them control their movements, become independent and adapt to society. Practical Life Exercises also aid in intellectual and concentration growth, helping students develop an organized way of thinking.

Sensorial Exercises

The Sensorial Exercises prepare the mind for mathematical thinking and encourage early language skills, cognitive growth, fine and gross motor skills, problem-solving skills and social interaction. Sensorial exercises help our students learn how to organize their environment, classify objects and use logic to make sense of the world around them.

Sports

Regular sports activities, combined with free play on our child-friendly play area, are integral to our students' physical fitness and mental well-being. Led by a professional sports teacher, these sessions not only promote physical health but also encourage teamwork, discipline, and resilience among our students.

Assessment

The students' progress is closely monitored by assistant teachers, class teachers, subject teachers, level coordinators and the Section Head. Daily behaviour reports help in the identification of areas of concern, whether it is academic or otherwise and aid in planning to overcome them. Remedial programs are carried out for those students who require special attention in certain academic areas. If required, problems are discussed with parents so that they can also play a positive role in helping their child cope. Report cards prepared on the basis of regular ongoing assessment are sent to the parents at the end of each term.

Material Time

The 'Material time' gives students the opportunity to unleash their potential by working with the Montessori material. Montessori material is especially designed to teach children various skills including better hand-eye coordination, self-discipline, self-correction and focus while enhancing cognitive skills and creativity. These activities lay the foundation for future learning. It is a wonderful time for students to engage in numerous tasks with the freedom to choose from the wide range of material. In AIS, we ensure the availability of sufficient age-appropriate Montessori material to keep all the students involved simultaneously.

Departure Time

The security of our students is extremely important for us and so departure time is exceptionally organised. A pick-up card system is in place, which authorises the card holder only to pick up the student.

After School Facility

Due to varied dismissal times of siblings, staff or even parents who are unable to make it to school on-time to pick up their children due to work hours, an after-school facility is available. This time is made purposeful for the students by engaging them in interesting activities, snacking or even taking a short nap and feeling refreshed before going home.

A Day at AIS Montessori

Notable Features

Orientation Day

In order to facilitate parents for the upcoming academic year, an Orientation Day is held to share with them the teaching techniques, rules, regulations and the support required from home.

Discipline in Hubs

Without a doubt, discipline is one of the most important aspects of the school. Students will always be found following their leader whilst walking in straight lines, waiting in a queue and keeping the noise level to a minimum. These traits become life-long valuable habits.

Qur'an Recitation Room

In the dedicated Qur'an Recitation Room (in select campuses), students recite their lessons aloud using microphones, sound systems, and other audio-visual aids to ensure clear pronunciation and mastery of Tajweed. In some campuses, teachers bring the same A/V setup into regular classrooms, supported by whiteboards, soft boards, Surah displays, and recordings, helping students develop a deep love and respect for the Holy Qur'an, In shā' Allāh.

Audio/Video Room

The audio-video room offers a fun, hands-on learning experience with the interactive smart board. Students engage in presentations, interactive apps, and exciting lessons, while teachers use tablets to enhance academic and cognitive skills. These rich experiences help students thrive and enjoy learning.

Kitchen Corner Activities

The Kitchen Corner is more than cooking, it teaches use of tools, ingredient recognition, counting, and weighing. Children also develop social and organizational skills while learning about healthy, Tayyab food. Wearing chef caps, they enjoy fun-filled hands-on experiences.

Primary Section

Our Primary Section is Alhamdulillah well on its way to attain the vision of the school where students are being trained in a positive environment by passionate and dedicated teachers. Our approach to learning is evolving every day; modern and innovative techniques are being adopted to educate the students. These techniques optimize self-belief, competence and proficiency.

The Primary Section comprises Grades I – IV; boys and girls are segregated from grade IV and onwards, where applicable.

Curriculum

Students are guided to become self-motivated learners, who are strong academically and are able to foster their own ability to think comprehensively and clearly. Our enriching curriculum is streamlined with the Single National Curriculum aimed to align high-quality education while developing 21st Century skills including analytical, critical and creative thinking.

Qur'an - Recitation and Memorization*

Qur'an Recitation encompasses teaching Naazrah, utilizing word break-up, blending, and word analysis on a whiteboard with the aid of a mind map. The recitation employs a phonetic reading approach, recognized as one of the most innovative and advanced techniques. Continuous reading skills are cultivated through recordings featuring esteemed Tajweed experts, ensuring a comprehensive and effective learning experience. Additionally, the Tajweed class includes the memorization of a section of the Holy Qur'an, enhancing students' proficiency and connection with the sacred text.

Arabic*

Our Arabic language curriculum is designed to empower students with reading, listening, speaking and writing skills, enabling them to grasp Arabic texts proficiently. The purpose of this subject is to make students able to read and understand the Holy Qur'an in its revealed language. It aims for students to read, identify the grammatical rules and comprehend the Arabic text. Arabic text comprehension is developed through dialogues, Islamic stories and Ahadith which serves as a foundation to understand the basics of Islamic teachings through original sources. Students not only learn the Arabic language but also gain insight into the Qur'an and Hadith directly from their primary sources.

English*

As an English medium school, students are encouraged to communicate fluently and effectively in English at AIS. During the year, all areas of the subject are covered; including reading, writing, listening and speaking effectively in English.

Urdu

As the national language, Urdu is highly valued at the school and is taught with the same zeal and emphasis as English and Arabic.

Mathematics*

Students are taught mathematical concepts which are reinforced through practical activities. The methodology adopted at AIS provides a platform for students to become independent in utilizing their mathematical skills. This approach helps form a strong foundation to build upon in coming academic years.

Islamic Studies*

The school has a thematic approach to the way Islamic Studies is taught, where a concept is reinforced in all aspects of teaching. Through this process students learn in an engaging manner, which helps increase their knowledge while enriching their faith and thus translating into action.

Science

Science is taught in such a way that students are made to realize and appreciate the grandeur of Allah ﷻ and His creation. They are motivated to understand the application of scientific concepts through experiments, diagrams, flow charts, documentaries and science projects. Exhibitions and competitions held by the school are an effective means to further nurture students' scientific inquisitiveness. Students are encouraged to make discoveries, devise formulae and experiment on their own.

Physical Education

Health and fitness is ensured by providing the students training in sports such as Martial Arts, Badminton, Table Tennis, Basketball, Gymnastics, Racing etc. All students partake in weekly physical activities.

General Knowledge

Students develop an understanding of the world through inquiry mediums such as painting, drawing and sketching. based learning about the Universe, Earth, environment and other cultures in General Knowledge, Social Studies and Life Skills. Emphasis is placed upon becoming responsible and active citizens of the world through practical projects and innovative research. Students derive important lessons from the past and benefit from a focused study of Muslim heroes. Students of Grade IV delve deeper into Pakistan Studies exploring Government, Economics, Culture, History & Geography of Social and Civic Sense.

Arts and Crafts

This subject is a way to expand students' imagination, broadening their horizon in being creative and helping them refine their gross and fine motor skills. Students use this time to express their emotions and feelings through various mediums such as painting, drawing and sketching.

Life Skills

Life skills are essential for the overall development of primary students. These skills extend beyond traditional academic subjects and play a crucial role in preparing students for various aspects of life. The purpose of Practical Life Skills is to help students gain control over the coordination of their movements, become independent, and adjust to their society. Therefore, it is crucial to "teach teaching, not correcting" in order to allow the child to be a fully functional member of their own society. Practical Life Skills Exercises also aid in the growth and development of the student's intellect and concentration, which, in turn, helps the child develop an organized way of thinking.

Leader In Me

The 'Leader in Me' program for Primary Section students introduces the seven habits of effective Muslims, inspired by the teachings of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and the Sahabah. Through engaging activities such as role-playing to practice kindness, collaborative projects, and creative expression, students cultivate essential values in a supportive environment. Daily journaling encourages reflection on empathy and responsibility, empowering them to grow into compassionate, confident young leaders who embody Islamic principles.

The Secondary Section encompasses grades V to VII, with separate facilities for boys and girls, fostering an environment that encourages focused learning and personal growth. Key Features

Curriculum

Qur'an Translation and Tafseer*

A distinctive feature of AIS is its commitment to strengthening students' connection with Allah ﷻ through a focused and meaningful study of the Qur'an. The Qur'an Translation and Tafseer program enables students to understand the Divine message and translate it into upright character, moral excellence, and responsible conduct in personal, family, and social life. Guided by qualified subject specialists, students are encouraged to engage in reflective thinking and develop insight into Allah's commands and the standards He has set for His believing servants, fostering conscious faith and practical implementation of Qur'anic teachings.

Qur'an - Recitation and Memorization*

Nazrah is instructed through techniques such as word break-up, blending, and word analysis on a whiteboard, focusing on technical words. This approach supports students in achieving continuous and independent recitation of the verses. Additionally, we organize annual and inter-campus Qiraat competitions to provide students with a platform to showcase their noble talents and skills. Furthermore, students are exposed to international-level competitions, broadening their horizons and fostering a spirit of excellence.

English*

While teaching English as a language we focus on reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. Urdu

Mathematics*

Mathematics is taught with reference to daily problem solving. 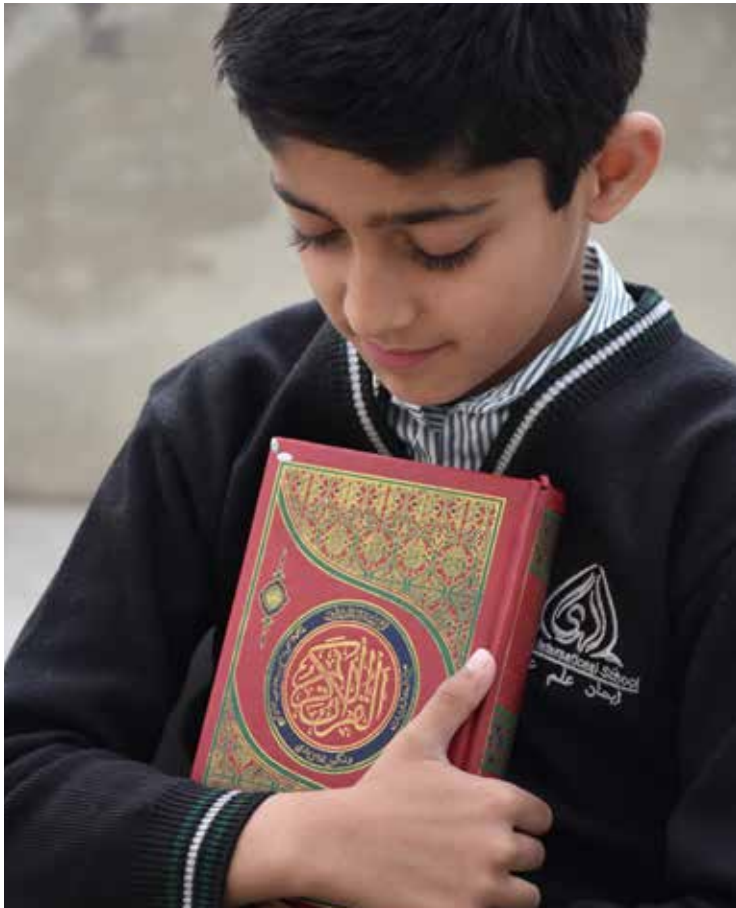
The memorization of Qur'an starts after the admission of students (ages 9 to 11 years) who can recite Nazrah Qur'an fluently, these students discontinue their school for two years and focus on Hifz only.

Program Overview

Applications for admissions to the Hifz program are accepted throughout the year and admissions are secured upon seat availability. Applications are submitted at the reception and saved in our database. Parents are contacted as soon as there is seat is available. Admission is secured if child qualifies in the interview and test. Being an Islamic institute, AlHuda International School recognizes the importance of memorizing the Holy Qur'an. Thus it facilitates its own students and outsiders to embark on this sanctified journey which will nothalt until one reaches the highest ranks of Jannah.

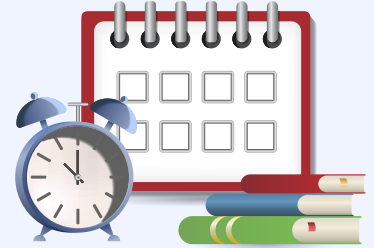

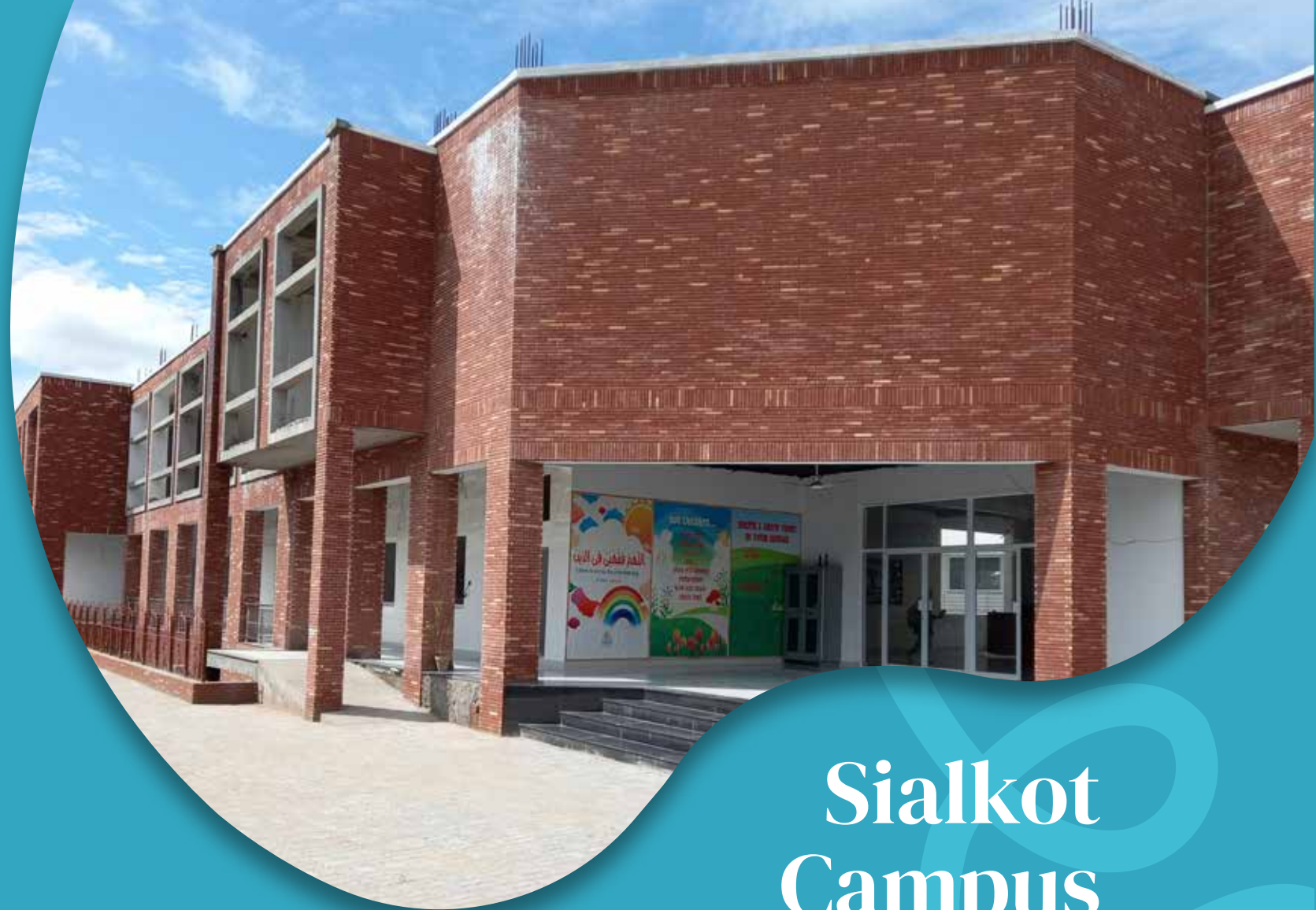
