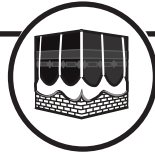


What is So Special About DhulHijjah?

The format of the takbeer is as follows:

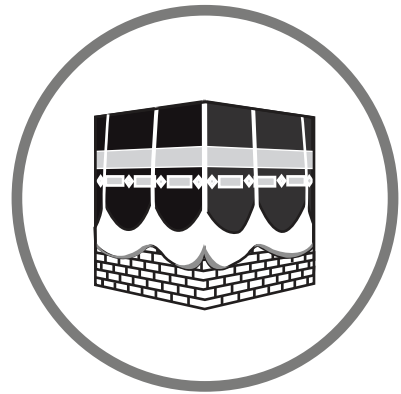

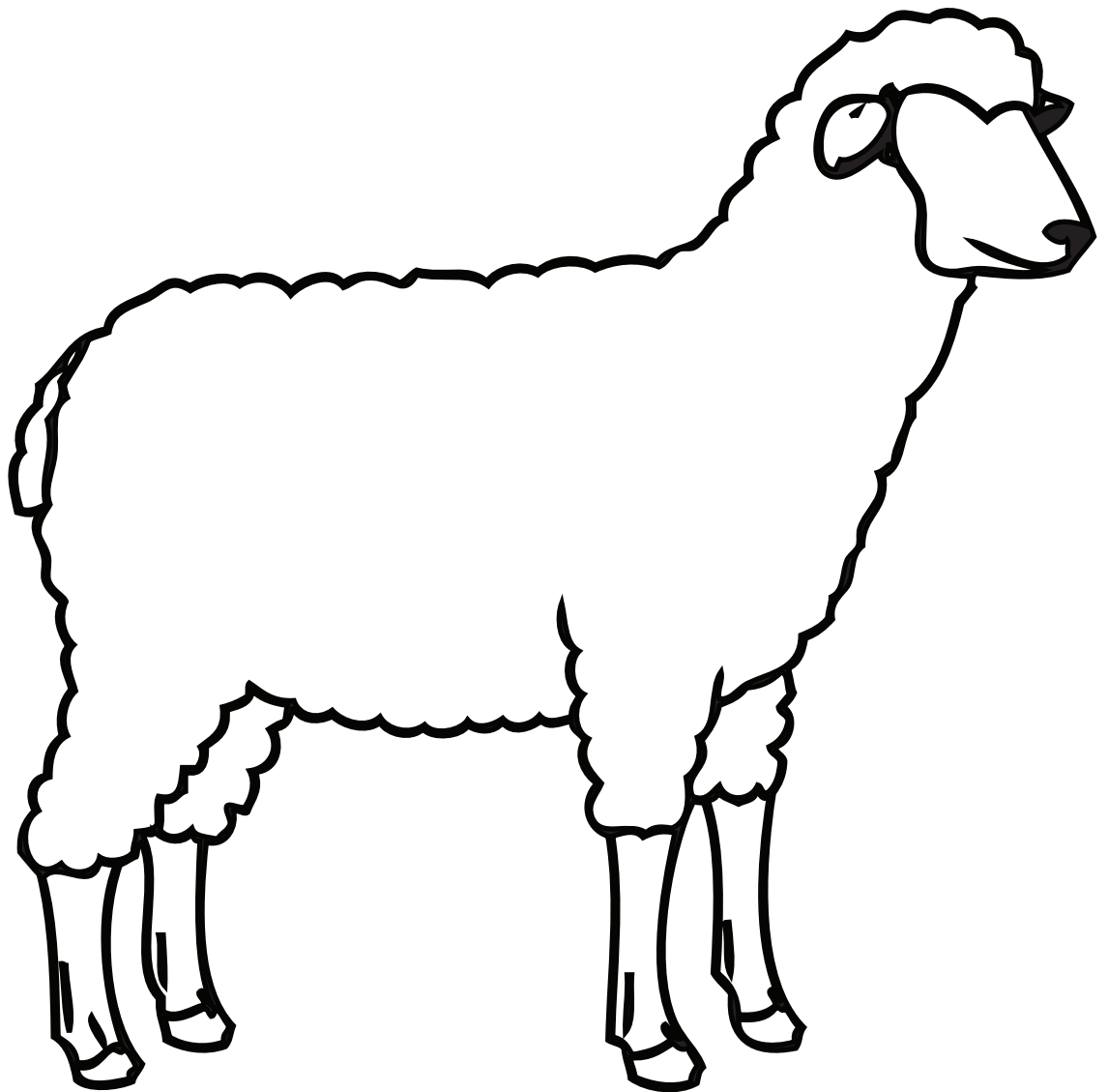
Sacrificing Animals on Eid-ul-Adha

Cross out the animals that are not sacrificed on Eid-ul-Adha.

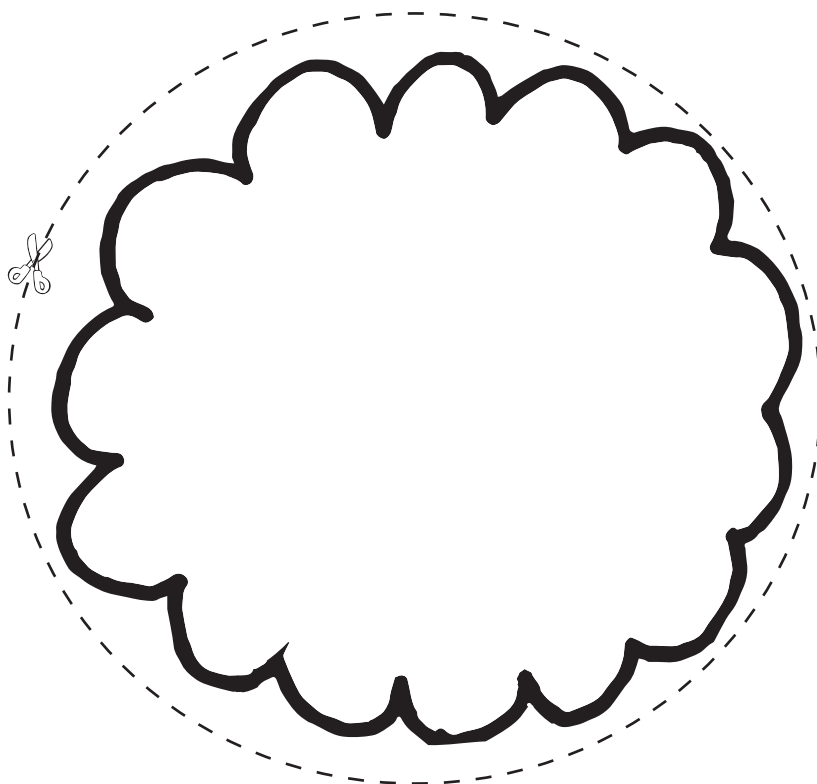


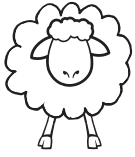
Sacrificing Animals on Eid-ul-Adha
